Proposal for County Financial Support concerning Illegal Dumping**

*Attached is the initial proposal which was tabled by the Commissioner's Court at the May 10, 2010 meeting.*

**Following is a list of points and potential issues if the County is provided a "free day at the county dump" IN LIEU of a roll-off dumpster:**

- 1) We could find no legal codes that prohibit the County from paying for community services in a private residential subdivision (a subdivision which is within the County and pays 28.43%, approx. 1/3, of the County's tax rolls);
- 2) There are approx. 75 miles of unpaved mountain roads within DMR and DMR's entrance is approx 15 miles from the county dump;
- 3) Most of DMR's residents are retired, many are elderly and a good number do not have the transportation ability to haul loads to town;
- 4) Having a roll-off dumpster in DMR will not only encourage community clean-up, it will better enable local neighbors to help load and haul disposables for those physically unable;
- 5) There is a relatively high potential of debris and other items falling off and/or being blown out of hauling vehicles during the 15 mile drive to the county dump (therefore, such circumstances would require clean-up);
- 6) If a dumpster is provided to DMR, such circumstances within DMR would become the responsibility of DMR (rather than the County);

**In addition to the Commissioner's Court suggestion to consider, for the entire county, a "Free Day at the County Dump", DMPOA, Inc. maintains its request the Commissioner's Court approve Jeff Davis County paying for:**

**One roll-off dumpster in the DMR, in 2010, for 1 week at the cost of: \$ 1,073.00**

*The DMPOA, Inc. will coordinate delivery and pick-up with Texas Disposal Systems. Preferred dates of service between June 25<sup>th</sup> and Labor Day weekend in September.*
