Annual Road Committee Report 7/2/2018 thru 6/29/2019

The Mission of the Road Crew is to improve the longevity of our roads with proper road design and water removal through adequate ditch drainage, water knock-outs, diversion mounds and culverts to minimize material loss.

The scheduling of road work follows the clockwise rotation of the Road Plan Map posted in the Community Center. The road plan is divided into six sections consisting of approximately seventy-five miles of road. The main road will be worked into the rotation as needed to maintain a safe roadway. During times of high traffic volumes, bad weather and extreme dry conditions, maintenance on the main road will require additional work as needed.

To achieve our goal, required time may be spent in a section to adequately construct the road bed geometry with the dozer. Furthermore, the Rock Crusher produces angular gravels which stabilize our clay based soils making a suitable road material. This processing is slow yet yields a long term solution for on-site material manufacturing.

February 2019- Bladed & Placed 2 loads of clay to add binder for loose gravels, Watered & Compacted March 2019- Bladed to cut "washboards", Placed 2 loads of clay to bind loose gravels, Watered & Compacted May 2019- Bladed to cut "washboards" after rain, Placed 1 load to reset caliche by Tomahawk Cattle Guard June 2019- Bladed to clean out side ditches & cut "washboards", Crushed windrows to build crown
