Road Work and Repairs

Section 1:

Worked 315 Colleen Canyon

• Placed 3 loads of rubble fill to build up washed out road edge

Section 2:

Worked Low Meadow with Dozer from 315 Low Meadow to High Meadow

• Removed pine tree at intersection to widen the turning radius at Skyline

Worked Skyline from Low Meadow to the turn-around

Dozer work to rebuild the road bed

Rock hammer work to break up all exposed embedded rocks

Haul and placed 5 loads of road mix to build back washed out sections

Trimmed limbs as needed, hauled 3 loads of limbs to the burn pile

Placed 4 loads of water as needed to set road bed work

Section 1:

Scheduled work to continue on upper Colleen Canyon next week

Rock hammer to be relocated for embedded rock removal

Several loads of materials are required to build up the creek crossings

Requests to work Tomahawk and the Ranch Road will be addressed

Equipment Repairs & Maintenance

580K Backhoe

- Serviced front loader bucket control valves, cleaned out debris causing binding 410G Backhoe
 - Replaced worn rock hammer bit with spare
 - Will machine and resurface the chisel face for future use

Mack Dump

- Replaced right rear tire with used spare, loss of tire tread
- Replaced right front air brake hose assembly
- Power steering pump hoses need to replaced, excessive leaking on low pressure side

Material Screen

• Welded upper frame corners with additional metal supports, added two screen brackets

Road Material Processing

- Excavated and hauled 14 loads of donated creek bed materials to the staging area
- Processed 11 loads or 145 cubic yards of road mix
- 120 cubic yards of caliche were delivered to the community center

Additional Information

- Pushed up Brush Pile as needed
- Installed new shut-off valve and filter on the fourth fuel tank for more storage capacity
- Off-road diesel and unleaded fuels were delivered
