

Road Committee Report

7/12/2021 thru 8/14/2021

Road Work Completed

Continued to work emergency road repairs after rains:

Tomahawk creek crossings, removed large rocks and added fill
Limpia Canyon Trail from Community Center to Tony's Pass, 1 load sand to fix seep
Community Center area to cover exposed water line at dip tank and phone line
Thompson Trail to smooth ruts, needs more road mix to cover rocky sections
High Meadow from tank to 200 High Meadow, placed mix to fill ruts and removed rocks
Saddle Bag hill to fill and smooth
Bandolero Culvert Bridge, removed tree stumps and debris, 1 load mix to cover culverts
Lower Tomahawk from Round Fire station to Crazy Horse crossing
Yellow Knife at Tejas intersection
Yellow Knife from Community Center to Yellow Knife Court, placed 2 loads of road mix
Colleen Canyon at 204 to remove stumps along road right of way for driveway entrance
Cochise Canyon water crossings, removed rocks and placed sand fill
Tejano Loop from Limpia Canyon to Tejano Loop Court
Tejano Loop from Limpia Canyon to McGuire Ridge

Worked High Lonesome from bottom of switchbacks to Fair View

- Placed 2 loads of rock fill to adjust pitch
- Placed 5 loads of road mix to set road bed
- Dozer and crusher work to improve crown and drainage

Worked Fair View with Dozer, placed 1 load mix, needs three more after diversion berms are set

Worked High Lonesome from Fair View to Turn-around, Dozer and Crusher, Trimmed limbs

Worked Cedar Trail to Cedar Trail Loop, will finish Dozer and crusher next week

Equipment Repairs & Maintenance

Mack Truck

- Found crack in lower radiator reservoir. Not holding water. Will find a replacement

580K Backhoe

- In the shop for more brake work on right transaxle

Road Material Processing

- Reclaimed 12 cubic yards of sand from 106 Squaw Valley crossing
- Reclaimed 72 cubic yards of creek gravels from 601 Tomahawk crossing
- Relocated 72 cubic yards of clay from duck pond inventory
- Processed 156 cubic yards of gravel and clay mix for road base

Additional Information

- Pushed up brush pile as needed
- 1000 gallons of Diesel fuel delivered
- Replaced toilet fill valve and flapper in Community Center, ordered sediment filters
- Scheduled to work repair requests on Limpia Canyon at Loop intersection
- Scheduled to work Main Road for Humming Bird Festival
