Discussion included:

- Plan to identify where culverts will be placed throughout the DMR and manpower to get the culverts installed.
- Identified areas to obtain material to patch existing road wash outs.
- Identified a potential volunteer group.
- Discussed safety issues and safety supplies needed.
- Discussed timing to drain lower pond to prep for excavation.
- Discussed delivery of donated concrete culverts to the DMR.
- Discussion regarding the purchase of a rock crusher that is capable of handling the size of rocks that we have to resurface our roads efficiently.

Work completed:

- During rainy days, Raymond is welding steel into the dump truck to reinforce the bed and performing maintenance on our equipment.
- Road crew spent much time keeping our roads and culverts cleared and patched after the heavy rains.
- Bandolero Bridge repaired after heavy rains.
- Road work was done on High Lonesome, Cedar Trail and Cedar Loop earlier in the month.
- Covered damaged culvert on Tomahawk by Dusty Hollow.
- Patching of washouts on Comanche Crest, Thompson Trail, Cross Trails, Saddle Bag, Bandolero, Squaw Valley, Buckboard Pass, Limpia, Stagecoach, Tomahawk, Cochise, Church Hill, Yellow Knife.
- Brush Pile cleaned up.
- Ray used the past week collecting material and patching areas around the Resort.
- Minor repair was made to screen.
