Road Work Completed

Worked Main Road from 166 to Tomahawk

- Bladed to remove wash-boarding
- Reclaimed materials from ditches to mix with loose gravel
- Crushed windrows as needed to build crown
- Placed rock fill to fix washed- out fence line at "Mud Tank"
- Reworked to repair muddy sections after rain

Equipment Repairs & Maintenance

Water Truck

- Purchased new tire
- Greased driveline and chassis

Dump Truck

- Greased driveline and chassis

Case Backhoe

- Purchased new front tire
- Serviced air filters and Greased chassis

John Deere 7420

- Replaced belt tension idlers and Belt

John Deere 410G Backhoe

- Changed engine oil and Filter
- Flushed fuel tank and replaced fuel filter
- Flushed radiator and filled with new anti-freeze
- Greased all fittings
- Inspection of machine to list items to be replaced
- Engine Control Unit was benched tested and failed
- Purchased new ECU, fuel pump, radiator and surge tank caps

- Sifted 5 loads of clay and reclaimed materials
