Road Work and Repairs

Section 6:

Working the Ranch Road from Highway 166 to Wofford's Gate

- Blade to build road bed, roll-in and water to set materials
- Compacted materials with large roller and 7420
- Need two more days to finish

Section 4:

Worked Bandolero from Winchester Pass to Six Shooter

- Blade, water and roll-in
- Placed 6 loads of road mix to work rocky sections

Reclaimed 11 loads of donated creek sand and gravels from 106/108 Bandolero Trail

Dozer prep work from 208 Low Meadow to 307

Removed large imbedded road rocks, adjusted pitch and drainage

Trimmed and hauled 1 trailer load of limbs from Limpia Canyon to brush pile

Scheduled to work Tomahawk from cattle guard to Community Center after Ranch Road

- Repairs to be addressed on Cross Trail from Tomahawk to Thompson Trail
- Installation of culvert at 103 for property owner's drive way

Equipment Repairs & Maintenance

580K Backhoe

- Serviced air filters, greased pivot points, added hydraulic fluid to transaxle
- Replaced front loader hydraulic hose on bucket roll

410G Backhoe

- Installed fuel tank, replaced fuel pickup strainer, gasket and fuel filter
- Currently replacing the fuel injectors and seals

International Water Truck

Low fuel pressure present at fuel filter test point after sitting overnight

Mack Dump Truck

• Radiator to be flushed a second time with a rust removal solution

Road Material Processing

- Reclaimed 11 loads of sand and gravel from 106/108 Bandolero Trial
- Excavated 3 loads of clay from 101 Limpia Canyon
- Processed 14 loads or approx 200 cubic yards of road mix

Additional Information

- Pushed up Brush Pile. Fireplace ashes continue to be dumped at brush pile, 2 new piles
- Community Center septic tank continues to clog. Ready to excavate and replace lines
- Road work schedule has resumed with Section 1 and requested repairs are being worked in
- It takes 3 days and a two man crew to process 250 cubic yards of road mix. Cost per yard is approximately \$5. Caliche cost per yard is \$31.25. Kiewit road base per yard is \$30.
