# Road Committee Report

04/10/2023 thru 05/13/2023

## Road Work and Repairs

#### Section 1:

Worked 317 to 400 Colleen Canyon

- Removed boulders to widen road bed on steep hill sections
- Trimmed limbs to provide equipment clearance
- Placed 2 loads of road fill and 1 road mix
- Cleared creek channel of tree debris and boulders
- Rock crusher work to process windrows and build up road bed

Worked Tomahawk from Community Center to Tomahawk cattle guard

Blade and watered as needed

## Section 2:

Worked 400 Low Meadow to Low Meadow Court turn-around with Dozer

Built up three water diversion mounds to divert water off of the road

Worked High Meadow from Low Meadow to 206 High Meadow

Dozer work to prep the road bed for rock hammer work

Installed two culverts at 206 High Meadow for property owners driveway entrances

- Adjusted road pitch and removed road bed boulders to better direct water
- Placed 2 loads of road mix and set with water as needed

Worked High Meadow from Cochise Canyon to 106 (High Meadow Well)

Placed 7 loads of pond mix to build up road bed

### Section 3:

Repair work at 606 Tomahawk

- Placed 1 load of road mix to cover rocky creek bed section
- More repairs are scheduled for lower Tomahawk

#### Section 6:

Worked Ranch Road from Tomahawk cattle guard to Highway 166

Blade and watered as needed with the remaining Duck pond water

## Equipment Repairs & Maintenance

#### Mack Dump

• Rotated front tires to the mid axle for better tire traction

# **Road Material Processing**

- Excavated and hauled 12 loads of Duck pond clay and sand mix to the staging area
- Processed 4 loads or 50 cubic yards of road mix
- Placed 7 loads or 84 cubic yards of pond mix on High Meadow

## **Additional Information**

- Pushed up Brush Pile as needed
- Removed a pile of wood pallets and scrap lumber that was "dumped" at the burn pile
- The emergency fire warning siren was removed from Apache Mountain and placed in storage until further notice. Siren has been inoperable for the past several years.
- The Duck pond is now out of water for use on the roads.
